KNOW ALL PERSONS BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT: The Principal identified above hereby appoints NYC Supply Chain Solutions Inc., a New York corporation and licensed U.S. customs broker located at 99 Tulip Avenue, Suite 405, Floral Park, New York 11001, through any of its licensed officers or authorized employees, as the Principal's true and lawful agent and attorney, with full power and authority to act for and in the name, place, and stead of the Principal at the appropriate Center and at all U.S. Customs and Border Protection ports, and to:

1. Make, endorse, sign, declare, swear to, prepare, file, and transmit any entry, entry summary, withdrawal, declaration, certificate, invoice, bill of lading, manifest, drawback claim, export document, protest, petition, application, post-entry submission, or other document required or permitted by law or regulation in connection with the importation, transportation, warehousing, exportation, admissibility, entry, release, liquidation, refund, or drawback of merchandise shipped or consigned by or to the Principal;
2. Perform every lawful act or condition required in connection with such merchandise; receive merchandise deliverable to the Principal; make endorsements on bills of lading conferring authority to transfer title, make entry, or collect drawback; and receive, endorse, and collect checks issued for customs duty refunds in the Principal's name drawn on the Treasurer of the United States;
3. Sign, seal, execute, and deliver for and as the act of the Principal any customs bond required by statute or regulation in connection with the entry or withdrawal of merchandise or the transaction of customs business, subject to all requirements of 19 C.F.R. part 113;
4. Sign, swear to, or verify any declaration, affidavit, certificate, statement, or other record required by law or regulation; submit protests under 19 U.S.C. § 1514 and 19 C.F.R. part 174; and receive and respond to lawful CBP notices and communications relating to the Principal's customs business;
5. Generally transact at the appropriate Center and at all CBP ports all customs business lawfully transactable by an agent on behalf of the Principal, including designating any other duly licensed U.S. customs broker to act as sub-agent, for whose customs business NYC Supply Chain Solutions Inc. remains responsible to the Principal, with full power to do every lawful act and thing necessary or proper in the premises; and the Principal ratifies and confirms all lawful acts performed under this authority.
6. Prepare, sign, file, and transmit Importer Security Filings (ISF) and related amendments on behalf of the Principal when requested. The Principal remains responsible for providing complete, accurate, and timely ISF data and for promptly advising the broker of any correction.

SPECIAL EXECUTION TERMS

Nonresident Principal. The Principal appoints NYC Supply Chain Solutions Inc., a resident of the United States, as its agent authorized to accept service of process against the Principal. A nonresident corporation that has not qualified to conduct business under the law of the State in which this authority is to be exercised must furnish documentation establishing the authority of the person executing this Power of Attorney on its behalf.

Partnership. This Power of Attorney states the names of all members of the partnership in the space provided below or on an attached schedule; a limited partnership must state the general partners authorized to bind it and must furnish a copy of the partnership agreement. A partnership Power of Attorney expires two years after the date of execution, and the same limit applies to a limited liability company that is recognized as a partnership under the law of its State of organization.

Corporate execution. If the person signing for a corporate Principal is not its president, vice president, treasurer, or secretary, evidence of that person's authority — a board resolution, certificate of incumbency, or equivalent — must be attached.

Records confidentiality (19 C.F.R. § 111.24). The broker's records concerning the Principal's customs business are confidential and will not be disclosed except as permitted by that section or as the Principal authorizes in writing below.

DISCLOSURE OF THE PRINCIPAL'S RECORDS IS AUTHORIZED TO (LEAVE BLANK TO WITHHOLD)

DURATION, REVOCATION, AND DIRECT RELATIONSHIP

Except for a partnership, this Power of Attorney is effective on the date signed and continues until revoked. Revocation is effective when written notice is received by CBP at a port of entry or electronically; the Principal must also promptly notify NYC Supply Chain Solutions Inc. This Power of Attorney is executed directly between the Principal and NYC Supply Chain Solutions Inc., not through a freight forwarder or other third party, and nothing may prevent direct communication between them.

NOTICE REGARDING PAYMENT OF CUSTOMS CHARGES — 19 C.F.R. § 111.29

If you are the importer of record, payment to the broker will not relieve you of liability for customs charges (duties, taxes, or other debts owed CBP) in the event the charges are not paid by the broker. Therefore, if you pay by check, customs charges may be paid with a separate check payable to the "U.S. Customs and Border Protection" which will be delivered to CBP by the broker.
